Environment & Education

- Working through bulb plantings at various common spaces, exploring plantings at the roundabout by the firehouse.
- Board to explore additional grant leads to support Bluffs restoration project and invasive control plan.
- Call for volunteers to remove mugwort and other invasive plants and assist with plantings.
- Board to finalize plans for mulch distribution in the coming weeks.
- Board to check with invasive plant expert on best way to address Knotweed removal.
- Efforts to finalize community events underway.

Old Business

- Motorized Vehicles on the Bluffs
 - Chief of Police put parking ban into the golf cart registration, Public Works Director has insisted that there is no digging on the right of way. Chief noted that Carnivale is not an event sponsored by the LIA.
- Fire Permits
 - Group agreed to table the discussion for the time being, but will distribute educational information about the risks.
- Name Change
 - Group agreed to explore a name change to more accurately reflect its mission of conservation and stewardship.
